

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GIMLI

BY-LAW 09-0021

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GIMLI TO AMEND BY-LAW 07-0045 OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GIMLI BEING THE BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR A VARIETY OF SITUATIONS TO PREVENT FIRES AND INCREASE LIFE SAFETY.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Gimli is of the opinion that the Rural Municipality of Gimli By-Law 07-0045 is deemed to be in need of revision;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Gimli, in meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1.0 That the By- Law be amended as follows:

All open-air fires subject to By-Law by inserting clause

3.2 a) No person shall burn any matter on any public property, public park or public beach area at any time without the prior approval of the Council or Authority having jurisdiction. Application for Burning Permits shall be made at the Administration Office of the Rural Municipality of Gimli a minimum of one month prior to the planned date for such a burn.

By deleting existing clause 3.2 and inserting

3.2 b) No person shall set any open-air fire and the owner, occupier or person in charge of any premises shall not permit any open-air fire to be set or to remain lit on any premises of which he or she is the owner, occupier or person in charge, unless the fire meets the requirement of this By-Law.
