RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GIMLI

BY-LAW NO. 13-0012

Being a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Gimli to establish regulations for the Gimli Public Beach.

WHEREAS Section 232 (1) of *The Municipal Act* provides that a council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

- (a) the safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of property;
- (b) people, activities and things in, on or near a public place or a place open to the public, including parks, municipal roads, recreation centres, restaurants, facilities, retail stores, malls, and private clubs and facilities that are exempt from municipal taxation;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Gimli enacts as follows:

THAT the following activities are not allowed on any Public Beach in the Municipality:

- 1. Dogs and animals
- 2. Fishing from the shoreline
- 3. Feeding of shore birds
- 4. Camping or tents
- 5. Motorized vehicles
- 6. Alcohol
- 7. Littering
- 8. Loud music
- 9. Open fires, BBQ's or cooking of any kind
- 10. Boats or motorized water craft inside identified swimming areas
- 11. Use of inflatable floatation devices such as tubes, air mattresses, or rafts when the yellow flag is flying

- 12. Fireworks
- 13. Use or disposal of glass containers
- 14. Sleeping on the beach between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- 15. Unaccompanied children under the age of 14 years

THAT Council may issue a permit for special occasions to allow activities described in clauses 9.0 and 12.0 above.

THAT clause 5.0 does not include Snowmobiles that are being driven on the designated routes, during the time period of November 1 and April 15 in each year, and are in compliance with the most current Operating Snowmobiles By-law.
