

Rural Municipality of Gimli

BY-LAW NO 05-0009

BEING a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Gimli providing  
for the regulating Skateboarding.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 232(1) of The Municipal Act of Manitoba Chap. M225  
states in part that a council may in a by-law:

*"232(1) A Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the  
following matters:  
(b) people, activities and things in, on or near a public place or a place open to  
the public, including parks, municipal roads, recreation centres, restaurants,  
facilities, retail stores, malls, and private clubs and facilities that are exempt  
from municipal taxation."*

AND WHEREAS persons Skate Boarding have repeatedly caused damage to municipal  
property, private property and been a nuisance to a great number of pedestrians, vehicle  
traffic and private property owners in the Municipality;


AND WHEREAS Council views it in the best interest of the Rural Municipality of Gimli  
to establish regulations for prohibiting Skateboarding in or near a public place or a place  
open to the public, including parks, municipal sidewalks, recreation centres, Gimli  
Recreation Authority property, restaurants, facilities, retail stores, malls, private clubs and  
facilities that are exempt from municipal taxation;


NOW THEREFORE Council of the Town of Gimli in meeting duly assembled, enacts as  
follows:

1. THAT no person shall Skate Board on in or near a public place or a place open  
to the public, including parks, municipal sidewalks, beach boardwalk, recreation  
centre property, restaurants, facilities, retail stores, malls, private clubs and  
facilities that are exempt from municipal taxation unless area is posted as Skate  
Boarding Permitted.
2. THAT no person shall Skate Board in the area commonly known as Rotary Park  
or Harbour Park and the boardwalk adjacent to the beach between Centre Street  
and Goldfield Drive and Centre Street east of First Avenue or upon the federal  
pier and dock areas.
3. THAT any person violating the provisions of this by-law may be arrested  
without warrant by any peace officer having jurisdiction within the Rural  
Municipality of Gimli.
4. THAT the person who contravenes the provisions set out in this by-law shall, for  
each offence, be liable upon summary conviction to a fine of not less than  
\$100.00 and not greater than \$300.00 plus costs. Each contravention of this by-  
law shall be deemed to be a separate offence.
5. THAT By-law 99-10 and By-Law 03-0014 be repealed.
