Important! For public safety reasons, NO items are allowed to be tossed from your parade float/vehicle. They must be handed directly to the intended individual watching the parade. Any food items being handed out are subject to Health Canada regulations.

Parade Guidelines:

- For safety reasons, no entry will throw candy, or any objects during the parade. You may have walkers handing out candy.
- The minimum age for walkers is five (5) years old.
- Any floats with small children must have at least one (1) adult present for supervision
- No entry will hand out literature, pamphlets, leaflets, brochures, flyers or any other written or printed materials to parade spectators.
- No discriminatory, religious, political, sexual or offensive floats, advertising or material(s) will be allowed to participate in any parade held in the RM of Gimli.
- No alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs will be consumed by any participants before or during the parade. Entries are responsible for the safety of spectators.
- All entries must be decorated.
- All marching members should complete the entire parade.
- Horse units must all be ridden by qualified riders and provide themselves with their own clean-up crew for the parade route and marshalling area.
